# QUIGG ISLAND COMMUNITY FOREST | Liberty

Securing a keystone property in the upper watershed demonstrates GRLT's commitment to serving the health of its community from the headwaters to the sea. GRLT worked with Jenness and Jim Robbins, who have owned this 40-acre parcel on the north end of Quigg Island since their days in high school, as well as many in the community, including the US Forest Service Community Forest Program. GRLT is looking forward to welcoming the community and working alongside residents, school and scout groups, Robbins Lumber Co, and CALL (Citizens Association of Liberty Lakes) to ensure the property is well tended and sustainably managed for future generations.

# SCHOOL HOUSE FARM | Warren

Buying local foods is a significant way everyone can participate in sustaining our way of life in Maine while contributing to reducing carbon emissions. This past year, School House Farm owner Yelena Burdina followed up on the vision of her partner Bill Beckwith, who passed in 2017, to permanently protect School House Farm along Route One in Warren. Their plan was to forever protect important farm soils, ensure the land is not otherwise developed and will support local farming. 52 acres with frontage along the St. George River is now conserved and abuts another 68 acres of farmland in easement. While farm soils will remain in production to provide local fruit and vegetables, these conservation properties also protect nearly 12 acres of estuarine marsh along the river and over a half mile of river frontage. This river buffer will help mitigate against storm surge and sea level rise.





# WESKEAG HEADLANDS | South Thomaston

From the vantage point of a wooded headland in South Thomaston, previously owned by David and Lorri Cousens, one can look out onto the Weskeag Marsh and surrounding conservation land. Always committed to the longer view, the Cousens worked with GRLT to sell their land at a bargain so that it would become part of the mosaic of over 1,500 acres of conserved land between the Weskeag Marsh and the St. George River in South Thomaston. The project could not have happened without the support of many individuals, private foundations, and public funding. Additionally, GRLT collaborated with Maine Coast Heritage Trust and the State of Maine W. Tyler Wildlife Management Area on this conservation project.



# UP AND DOWN THE RIVER

Spanning the headwaters to the sea, GRLT completed important conservation projects in 2020, safeguarding critical wildlife habitat, securing access to local foods, and creating public access to spectacular waterfronts.



# CELEBRATING ART AND NATURE

The Land Trust continues to celebrate and share in the excitement at the Langlais Sculpture Preserve, a unique property that evokes the intersection of art and nature. Throughout 2020, hundreds of people came out to safely experience the joy of Bernard "Blackie" Langlais' work in Cushing amidst the 90-acre conserved property. With the help of volunteer stewards, guests were welcomed to tour the sculpture preserve along the universally accessible trail, stand in the shadow of whimsical 30-foot tall animal sculptures and visit the artist's studio and workshop.



#### Keeping Langlais' Artistic Legacy Alive

In the fall of 1979, Elizabeth Scott Porter was walking with friends in Cushing when they happened to pass by Blackie Langlais' place. She was fascinated by the monumental totem and animals and asked if she could explore. "Blackie was in the barn and welcomed us and we wandered around riveted by his sense of humor and giant talent." She fell completely and totally in love with *Mr. Warthog*, bought him and he soon found a home in her Washington, D.C. garden.

When Mrs. Porter decided to move across the country to a smaller place, it was time for Mr. Warthog to come back to Cushing. After years outdoors, it needed restoration to tease back its quirky personality. Douglas Smith, a local artist and art conservator, spent 70 hours restoring the wooden sculpture to its former self and it now lives happily inside the Little Barn among the rest of Blackie's menagerie.

#### **Pollinator Garden**

"Sleep, creep, leap!" So goes a saying about the first three years of a perennial garden, and in 2020 our pollinator garden really took off. Previously, Master Garden volunteers worked with GRLT to plant more than 260 native plant seedlings, plugs, and transplants to provide food and shelter for pollinators and birds. In the summer, the garden exploded in color and variety, a safe haven for native populations of birds, bees, and other insects.






